Water Testing

As per regulation, our water is consistently tested to ensure it's safe for drinking. In our most recent series of tests, the copper level was at 0.625 mg/L, which is significantly below the allowable amount of 1.300 mg/L. The lead level came in at 0.0061 mg/L, which is far below the permissible amount of 0.0150. These results mean that <u>our water is safe for drinking</u>. We will continue to perform all necessary tests to ensure it's safety. If you would like more information and/or to see the testing results, please go to our school website.
