Dear Dunham Parents and Guardians,

As we prepare for a hopeful return to on-campus learning this spring, we wanted to update our information. When we reopen, due to required safety guidelines, this school year we will be returning in a hybrid model.

Our hybrid model is an A/B instructional model. Group A students will attend Tuesday and Wednesday. Group B students will attend Thursday and Friday. Monday will be a distance learning day for all students. With this model, students will have three distance learning days and two on campus instruction days. Families also have the option to continue to do distance learning for the reminder of the school year (through June 2021).
