RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE DUNHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT

In the matter of determining whether the Dunham School District has sufficient textbooks and instructional materials, pursuant to Education Code section 60119.

- WHEREAS, the governing board of the Dunham Elementary School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on <u>September 12, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.</u>, which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;
- WHEREAS, the governing board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;
- WHEREAS, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;
- WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district/county office of education, and;
- WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;
- WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:
 - Mathematics Bridges (Grades TK-5) & College Preparatory Math (Grade 6)
 - Science FOSS (Grades K-5) & Pearson (Grade 6)
 - History-Social Science Harcourt (Grades K-3) & Houghton Mifflin (Grades 4-6)
 - English/Language Arts Houghton Mifflin

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instruction materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or healthy classes.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that for the 2023/2024 school year, the Dunham School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
